

## ELIGIBILITY

### Diploma in General Nursing and Midwifery (DGNM)

1. Passed 10+2 with English from recognized board under AISSCE/ CBSE/ ICSE / SSCE / HSCE or other equivalent Board.
2. Passed in all subjects of 10+2 with minimum 50% aggregate.
3. Minimum age for admission will be 17 years. (as on 31<sup>st</sup> December, 2023) The upper age limit is 35 yrs.
4. Ability to read, write and communicate in English.

### B.Sc (Hons.) Nursing

1. Passed 10+2 with Science (PCB) & English Core/English Elective from central/state/NIOS or other board as recognised by central government and must have obtained a minimum of 45% marks in Physics, Chemistry and Biology taken together and passed in English individually.
2. Qualified NEET 2023
3. Ability to read, write and communicate in English.
4. Minimum age for admission will be 17 years. (as on 31<sup>st</sup> December, 2023) The upper age limit is 35 yrs.

### Post Basic B.Sc Nursing

1. Passed 10+2 from recognized board under AISSCE/CBSE/ICSE/ SSCE/HSCE or other equivalent Board.
2. Obtained a certificate in General Nursing and Midwifery
3. Should be registered as R.N.R.M. with the State Nurses Registration Council.

### M.Sc Nursing

1. Passing of B.Sc. Nursing/B.Sc. (Hons.) Nursing/Post Basic B.Sc. Nursing with minimum of 55% aggregate marks.
2. Minimum one year of work experience after Basic B.Sc.Nursing. Or Minimum one year of work experience prior or after Post Basic B.Sc. Nursing.
3. Should be a Registered Nurse and Registered midwife or equivalent with any State Nursing Registration Council.

### Ph.D Nursing

1. Passed M.Sc. (Nursing) with a minimum of 60% marks.
2. 3 years teaching or Clinical experience after M.Sc. (Nursing)
